Content

Unit 1 covers the following topics:

- the role of the paediatric first aider
- dealing with emergencies
- management of an unconscious casualty
 - management of a casualty who is not breathing normally
 - CPR (baby, child & adult procedures)
- Safe use of an Automated External Defibrillator
- management of a casualty who is choking
- management of a casualty who is in shock
- management of a casualty who has a bleeding wound

It also provides the opportunity to practise the skills needed to administer first aid to an infant, child or adult who is:

- unconscious
- not breathing
- choking
- bleeding from a wound and in shock

Unit 2 covers the following topics:

- dealing with chronic medical conditions and sudden illness
 - diabetes
 - meningitis
 - asthma
 - anaphylaxis – includes adrenaline auto-injector
- dealing with the effects of extreme heat and cold
 - hypothermia
 - heat exhaustion
 - heat stroke
- management of casualty with suspected fracture and dislocation
- management of casualty with head, neck or spinal injury
- dealing with conditions affecting the eyes, ears and nose
- dealing with minor injuries
- dealing with electric shock
- dealing with burns and scalds
- dealing with poisoning
- dealing with bites and stings
- records and reporting

It also provides the opportunity to practise the skills needed to administer first aid to an infant, child or adult who:

- requires a support sling
- requires an elevation sling
- has a suspected spinal injury
